Hot and Cold.

Then put them in order from the very coldest to the very warmest.

Caring for our Environment - Plastic Pollution

Think about all the items in your house that are made out of plastic.

Make a list of how you use plastic throughout the day e.g. plastic milk bottle at breakfast, plastic bag for bread, plastic tub for margarine, bottle of water, chair, telephone, cycle helmet, computer, television, games console. What would your life be like without plastic?
